Other

Wastewater Treatment Agreement with the City: Staff is still working at
addressing your questions raised at the September 12, 2012 meeting. We just
received the requested additional financial information from the City's consultant
in order to further evaluate the previously presented scenarios. Because of the
WASWD Conference and other required staff training during this week we do
not have the final draft document available for discussion at this time. However,
we may be able to address some of your questions by the time of the
Wednesday meeting.

• Public Works Trust Fund Loan Application Status: As you may recall, early this year the District applied for a loan from the Washington State Public Works Trust Fund (PWTF) for future large projects identified within our capital improvement plan. The District had originally planned to go out into the private bond market in the 2013/2014 time frame in order to fund some of these projects. However, we had the opportunity to secure funding through the State at more favorable rates and conditions.

As previously reported, we applied for \$5,695,000.00 through the PWTF. We received notice on September 17th that we are being recommended for funding of the full amount for 2014. The recommended amount will now go forward to the State Legislature in January 2013 for final approval. The Legislature typically approves the PWTF's recommended funding level. Interest rates are projected to be between .05% and 1% over a 20 year time frame. Final acceptance of any loan would ultimately come back to the Board for approval.
