BACKGROUND / EXPLANATION OF IMPACT

As part of the 2014 Capital Improvement Plan, the District allocated \$120,000 for water system reinvestment. This year's project replaces old fire hydrants in Sudden Valley for which replacement parts are no longer available. The project has two objectives: (1) replace some of the 30 to 40-year old fire hydrants, and (2) stockpile old hydrants as a source of spare parts for remaining hydrants.

An Advertisement for Bids was published in the Bellingham Herald on 6/20/2014. A pre-bid meeting was held on 7/10/2014. Bids were due on 7/16/2014. Staff is reviewing the low bidder's references and Bidder Responsibility Criteria. Tentatively, a recommendation to award will be presented at the meeting.

FISCAL IMPACT

The District's 2014 budget includes \$120,000 for water system rehabilitation and replacement. While preparing the rate study this last spring FCSG recommended reducing funding of this project to \$100,000 if possible. Staff prepared bid documents that allow bid item quantity adjustments to meet the District's target budget of \$100k.

Based on the low bidder's unit prices, approximate 23 hydrants can be installed as estimated below.
