BACKGROUND / EXPLANATION OF IMPACT

This capital improvement project retrofits Strawberry Point Sewer Pump Station's existing Smith & Loveless wet well mounted pumps with new submersible pumps, controls, telemetry, and retaining wall.

An Advertisement for Bids was published in the Bellingham Herald on 1/6/2016. A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting was held on 2/3/2016. Two (2) bids were received and opened on 2/10/2016. Staff is evaluating the bids and supplemental bidder responsibility criteria. A recommendation will be made at the board meeting.

FISCAL IMPACT

The approved 2016 budget includes \$400,000 for the construction contract. The engineer's estimate for construction was \$371k. The low bid was \$399k and the second low bid was \$408k. (All costs include state sales tax.)
