- <u>Strawberry Point Sewage Pump Station Improvements Contract Award</u>
 Sorensen reported that the purpose of this project is to retrofit the Strawberry Point Sewer Pump Station's existing Smith & Loveless wet well mounted pumps with new submersible pumps, controls, telemetry, and retaining wall. An Advertisement for Bids was published on 1/6/2016. Two bids were received and opened on 2/10/2016. Staff has evaluated the bids and supplemental bidder responsibility criteria and recommends that the contract be awarded to Tiger Construction in the amount of \$399,323.40 including sales tax. Discussion followed.

Millar moved, Casey seconded, to award the Strawberry Point Sewer Pump Station
Improvements Redesign construction contract to Tiger Construction for a total
contract amount of \$399,323.40 including state sales tax and to authorize the
General Manager to sign and execute the contract. Motion passed.

Other Business
 At the February 10th meeting, one of the Commissioners asked about purchasing health insurance through the District's plan. Staff investigated and found that per state law the District is required to have a minimum of 5,000 service connections in order to provide health insurance for its Board members. The District has only 4,000 service connections.
