## CURRENTLY

- There are $\mathbf{5 0}$ days between the bill date and the due date.
- Payment is due on the 20th of the following month.
- There are about 100 days between the bill date and potential meter lock due to past due balance.



## IN THE FUTURE

- There will be $\mathbf{2 5}$ days between the bill date and the due date.
- Payment will be due on the 25th of the same month.
- There will be about 60 days between the bill date and potential meter lock due to past due balance.
- Since our current bill cycles were put in place, work flows have changed and evolved.
- Shortening the billing cycle length brings us more in line with industry standards.
- Due dates are changing, bill dates are not. Customers will still be billed every 2 months.


Geneva \& North Shore residents will still receive bills in odd months. Your first bill on the new cycle will be dated January 1, and be due January 25, 2024.

## Naw DUE DATES

Sudden Valley residents will receive bills in even months. Your first bill on the new cycle will be dated February 1, and be due February 25, 2024.
