Inspection may, at the discretion of the District, include a full mechanical inspection and test drive of up to 10 miles. In the event that the vehicle does not meet the needs of the District, the District may, at their sole discretion, decline to purchase the vehicle. All costs associated with delivery of the vehicle to the District, whether a purchase is made or not, shall be borne by the bidder.
